

# The 3rd KSASA Biennial Conference

## ***CALL FOR PAPERS***

The 3rd Korean Studies Association of Southeast Asia (KSASA) Biennial Conference will be held in Bangkok, Thailand, hosted jointly by ARC-Chulalongkorn University and KSC-Burapha University, during 8-10 October 2008. The theme of the conference is “Korean Studies in Southeast Asia in the New Era of Cultural Interactions”.

KSASA welcomes research papers in any field related to Korean studies. The papers in the competitive sessions will be selected through a double blind refereeing process. Papers are invited in all areas of Korean Studies, including Literature, Linguistics & Language Education, History, Religion, Sociology, Politics, Economics & Business, and Media & Communication. A number of renowned guests are already invited to join the conference. However, more papers, particularly in the areas of history and culture are most welcome to add in the scientific program. The papers will be selected through a double blind refereeing process.

Scholars who wish to submit a paper should forward an abstract to the Conference Secretary Ms. Pataravadee Sahaphongse (Email: arckfas@chula.ac.th) by 5 July 2008. The abstract should be not longer than 300 words but should have a separate title page and a list of references. The name, affiliation and address of the authors should appear only on the title page. Submissions are accepted only in an electronic form by email, and the paper should be saved in MS-Word format.

KSASA plans to provide some financial assistance toward the travel expenses for the authors, whose paper are selected by the OC for presentation. The details of the financial assistance will be determined later, depending on the number of papers and the amount of the grant available.
